

## **ONLINE INTERVISION WITH A CREATIVE FLAIR – TOOLS AND SECRETS TO OUR BOND**

This workshop invites you into the lived experience of the “**Leadership – Identity – Teams**” (LIT) **Intervision Group**, formed in 2021 by seven supervisors from Hungary, Norway, Lithuania, Estonia, and Croatia. Over time, our online circle has become a trusted space for professional growth and personal connection – without ever meeting in person as a group. During this workshop we will share the *tools*, the *structures*, and the *unspoken ingredients* that keep our group dynamic, meaningful, and alive.

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### ◆ **Part 1 – The Foundations of Lasting Connection**

*What helps an intervision group stay vibrant over time?*

In this first session, we share *stories and insights from our own experience* in the LIT group – how we built and sustained a strong bond across countries, time zones, and screens.
